Late Khalifa bin Zayed Al Nahyan

Former President of the United Arab Emirates

(7 September 1948 – 13 May 2022)

Sheikh Khalifa bin Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan (7 September 1948 – 13 May 2022) was the second president of the United Arab Emirates and the ruler of Abu Dhabi, serving from November 2004 until his death in May 2022. Source: en.m.wikipedia.org/

During his time as leader of the country, the late president played a crucial role in bringing the UAE into the 21st century.

Sheikh Khalifa was known for being an excellent listener, modest, giving, and concerned about his people, and he frequently engaged in direct outreach through official missions and other events.

As a result of his just and rapid leadership abilities, he was well-liked and respected. Here are some of his major accomplishments before and after becoming President of the United Arab Emirates:

When Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan, the UAE's Founding Father, relocated to Abu Dhabi city in 1966 to become the emirate's ruler, he nominated his eldest son Sheikh Khalifa, then 18 years old, as his representative in the Eastern Province and the president of the legal system.

Sheikh Khalifa continued his father's legacy by implementing substantial development initiatives in the Eastern Province, particularly those aimed at improving agriculture. Sheikh Khalifa's outstanding achievement in Al Ain marked the start of a long career in public service that saw him effortlessly accept his leadership role.

Sheikh Khalifa held a number of important positions in the years that followed. He rose through the ranks of his late father's government's executive branch, managing the implementation of all significant projects on both the municipal and federal levels.

February 1, 1969 – The Crown Prince of Abu Dhabi, Sheikh Khalifa, has been nominated. He was named Head of the Department of Defense in Abu Dhabi the next day. He directed the formation of the Abu Dhabi Defence Force (ADDF), which eventually became the UAE Armed Forces' nucleus.



July 1, 1971 – He was named Ruler of Abu Dhabi and Minister of Defense and Finance as part of the emirate's government reform.

December 23, 1973 – In the second cabinet, Sheikh Khalifa was appointed deputy prime minister.

January 20 1974 – He became the first Chairman of the Abu Dhabi Executive Council, which took the role of the emirate's local government.

November 3, 2004 – Following the death of Sheikh Zayed on November 2, 2004, he was elected to the presidency.

Sheikh Khalifa started a proposal to change the nomination system for members of the Federal National Council after his father's death and his ascension to the presidency of the UAE, which was considered as a first step toward the introduction of direct elections in the UAE.

Developmental projects

The Executive Council, led by Sheikh Khalifa, oversaw the implementation of substantial development programs in Abu Dhabi, including the building of houses, a water supply system, roads, and general infrastructure, which led to the city's transformation into the modern city it is today.

Manica Province

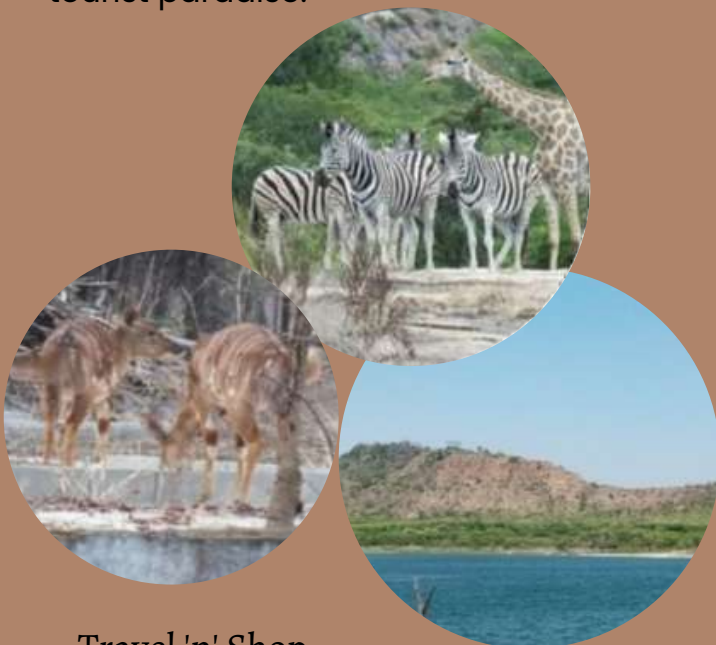
Manica province is located in the interior of the central region of Mozambique, bordered to the north by the province of Tete, to the east by the province of Sofala, and to the south by the provinces of Inhambane and Gaza. To west Zimbabwe.

Its capital is the city of Chimoio, about 1100 km north of Maputo, the national capital, and about 200 km west of the coastal city of Beira. With an area of 61,661 km². The town lies on the railway line from Beira to Harare, near the Cabeça do Velho (old man's head) rock. Located about 95 km from the Zimbabwean border.

It is in the province of Manica that the highest point in Mozambique is found: Mount Binga, with an altitude of around 2436m. A fascinating place, full of mysteries and myths that make it a true tourist paradise.

The Province has a socio-tourist potential with natural cultural heritage, consisting of plant communities or areas that contain a variety of types of landscape and ecosystem elements, places inhabited by plants and animals, some endangered species, undisturbed environments or that are influenced by natural processes and historical-cultural heritage, such as places of spiritual importance for communities (forests, trees, lakes, and sacred rivers), caves, cave paintings, forts, archaeological sites, among others.

Only inland tourism is practiced in Manica, with an ecotourism potential distributed over almost all regions, with historical sites of high heritage value and tourist interest. The Chimanimani Transfrontier Reserve, the Rock Paintings of Chinhamapere, Mukondiwa, and Mushabaka, in Manica District, Mavita, Mussapa, and Mvuratsvuku, in Sussundenga, Nhansana in Guro District. In addition to these, you can appreciate several forts, ruins, and buildings built before 1920.



Climate

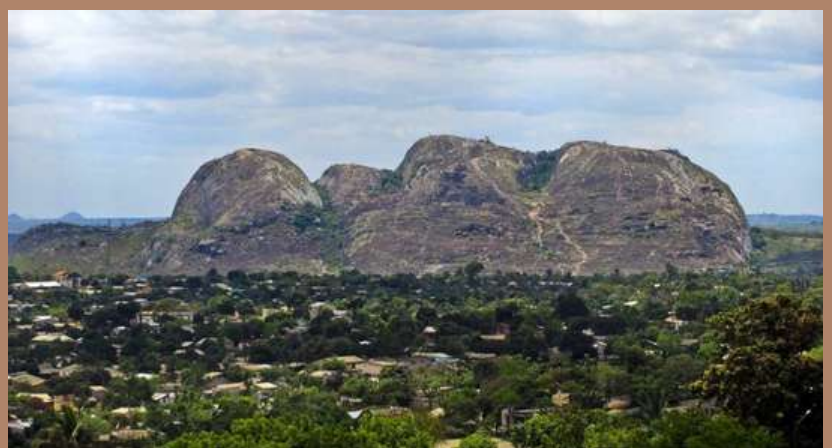
The Province of Manica is characterized by a tropical climate altered by altitude, with a tendency for hot and humid, with two distinct seasons: a rainy one, from September to March, and a dry one, from April to August. Average summer temperatures are 20°C and occur in half of the province. However, the hottest temperatures (25°C) occur in the Save and Zambezi Valleys. The coolest temperatures (15 to 20°C) occur in the districts of Gondola, Manica, Mossurize, Báruè, and in the mountainous areas to the West.

The average annual precipitation reaches 1,400mm. In dry regions, it does not exceed 700 mm and in high interior areas, it can reach 1,800 mm. In the dry period, sometimes morning fogs appear, characteristics of the transition seasons between the wet and dry seasons, occurring mainly in the high regions, which can be followed by local showers and /or heavy rains.

Tourist Potential of the Province

Mount Cabeça de Velho (Mount Head of Old Man), serves as a “business card” for visitors and is located 5 km east of the city center. The rock mountain, resembling a human head lying on its back, offers conditions for the practice of photographic tourism, religious tourism (pilgrimage, religious meetings)

Community tourism, cultural tourism (cultural tours, hiking, and picnics), observation of some animal species such as blue and red-tailed geckos, baboons, birds, and snakes. On the chin rises an ancient beard, formed by leafy trees that host different types of birds. The Tourist-cultural Festival “Cabeça do Velho”, the first of its kind, of local initiative and of this dimension, arises in recognition of the importance and historical-cultural role of Monte Bengo.



How to get to Manica?

By air: From Maputo international airport, and at other national and international airports.

Road: About an 80km drive from National Road N1.

Railway: About 290km from the city of Beira, when using the train.

Casa Msika Lodge is 55km from Chimoio city and has an excellent view of the dam and conditions for the practice of sport and recreational activities such as fishing, game view, landscape contemplation, and hiking. Further, there is wildlife that includes: Nyala, Kudus, Impalas, Giraffes, zebras, and crocodiles.



Quinta da Fronteira - Located 22km from Manica town, has a sacred forest of natural flowers, endowed with beautiful birds and sceneries, sources of clean e crystalline waterfalls, natural lagoons, proper conditions for pool diving, viewing, and mountain climbing in the surroundings mining scenery. Apart from these activities, there is more to explore and merge into this magical beauty.

Chimanimani National Park is a transboundary conservation area established in 2000, it has a rich ecosystem, especially in the mountainous areas which is why TIME Magazine quotes "with a vast landscape, including the highest peak in Mozambique, Mount Binga, the park is home to rare mountain elephants and dozens of different types of birds, reptiles, butterflies and plants that are unique to the area" variety of spectacular landscapes and pictorial scenarios that consist of mountains, plateaus, forests, rivers, waterfalls, ponds, and high biodiversity.



Manhwa Waterfalls are located in the Chikukwa zone inside the park, near the Zimbabwe border, at 126km from Chimoio city. The waterfalls have a natural huge swimming pool, and a beautiful landscape, where visitors can bathe or swim, and take photographs, make videos due to its beautiful and unique landscape that one can contemplate.

Bangladesh is a South Asian country. It is the world's tenth most populous country, with over 163 million people living in an area of roughly 147,570 square kilometers (56,980 square miles), making it one of the world's most densely populated countries. Bangladesh shares land boundaries with India to the west, north, and east, as well as Myanmar to the southeast, and the Bay of Bengal to the south. The Siliguri Corridor separates it from Bhutan and Nepal, and the Indian state of Sikkim in the north separates it from China by 100 kilometers. Dhaka, the country's capital and largest city, serves as the country's economic, political, and cultural nerve center.

The second-biggest city is Chittagong, which is also the country's largest seaport.
