### **ROMANIA NATIONAL GREAT UNION DAY**

Romania's National Day, also known as the Great Union Day, is observed annually on December 1 and honors the 1918 union of Transylvania, Bessarabia, and Bukovina with Romania, which at the time was composed of the Moldovan and Wallachian provinces

One of Romania's greatest hopes was realized over a century ago when the country united the states where the majority of the population was Romanian to form the Romanian Kingdom. Today, Romanians commemorate this unique occasion on December 1 every year as the Great Union of 1918. All eyes are on the capital Bucharest and the town of Alba Iulia, where the Great Union declaration was signed, while military parades and other celebrations are scheduled in places across the country..

What Is Romania National Day Celebrated For? - On December 1, 1918, over 100,000 Romanians gathered in Alba Iulia to witness Romania's unification announcement made by leader Vasile Goldis. The Old Romanian Kingdom merged with Transylvania and other nearby areas under the reign of King Ferdinand I, virtually tripling the size of this Eastern European nation. Romanians observe this day today in remembrance of their union 100 years ago.

## History of Romania National Day

The nation's unification in 1918 is commemorated on Romania's National Day. Although Romania's full independence was declared in 1878, it wasn't until December 1, 1918, in the city of Alba Iulia, that Transylvania, Crisana, Banat, and the Maramures area joined Romania, which was originally made up of Moldova and Wallachia.

The "statement of unification" was read in front of a large crowd of Romanians in Alba Iulia, where the union took place. Vasile Goldis, an academic and politician from Romania, read the declaration.

The National Days of Romania have been observed on May 10, August 23, and December 1 throughout the nation's history. Following the dissolution of the Romanian Communist Party and Soviet in 1990, December 1 was chosen as the official date of the country's national holiday.

### **Celebrations & Activities**

Romania celebrates National Day as a public holiday, with banks, government buildings, and for-profit companies all having the day off. Speaking engagements take place in Bucharest and Alba Iulia, the locations of the first readings of the unity declaration.

Tens of thousands of ecstatic Romanians brave the bitter cold to gather to observe military parades and tanks on Great Union Day.

Around the country, military parades are being planned, with the armed services marching in their finest attire and toting the flag of the country. The Romanian National Anthem and patriotic songs are played by army bands as they march through the streets of the nation.

In most cases, the festivities start in the early morning and end about midday. The largest military parade in the country may be seen in Bucharest, the nation's capital. Infantry, mounted troops, tanks, and several other military units and vehicles move in an orderly fashion along the town's highways. The simultaneous display of all these armed force departments' cutting-edge armory is quite remarkable. People congregate with friends and family to celebrate after the procession. They would rather go shopping, spend time with the family, have dinner together, or do anything else to enjoy their holiday

In recent years, various city halls have chosen to host family festivals, game shows, and concerts to commemorate the day.

## **INTERESTING FACTS**

- The merger of Romanian states is commemorated on December 1 with a public holiday known as Romania's National Day or Great Union Day.
- The town of Alba Iulia hosted the signing of the Union documents. In 1918, the declaration was then publicly read in front of 100,000 Romanians.
- In 1940, Romania lost control of Bucovina and Basarabia, which were later annexed by the Soviet Union. This occurred during World War II. Hungary gained a small portion of Transylvania, and Bulgaria gained Cadrilater.
- In 1878, Romania won its freedom from the Ottoman Empire.
- The national holiday of Romania has changed locations multiple times in previous years. On May 10, which commemorates Carol I's entrance into Romania in 1866 and his subsequent proclamation of independence from the Ottoman Empire in 1877, the national holiday was observed before 1918. August 23rd, which commemorated the overthrow of the fascist government in 1944, became a national holiday beginning with communist rule in 1944. December 1st has been recognized as Romania's National Day or Great Union Day since the fall of communism in 1990.

## FIKANI 2022 Mozambique

Mozambique's tourism potential is unquestionable. The country has numerous tourist resources that place it as a preferred tourist destination at regional and international level.

Mozambique has a strategic location, with 2.500 Kilometers of coastline, gastronomy, monuments, and cultural diversity are unique opportunities to explore, providing the country with comparative advantages and economic gains. Known as the "Pearl of the Indian Ocean", Mozambique also has an extensive coastline with a unique marine biodiversity, reserves, natural parks, and a landscape beauty that attracts first-rate eyes of those who see it. An excellent tourist destination that is worth promoting, to attract more visitors, investments, and revenue for the State.

Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, FIKANI Mozambique, International Tourism Fair was canceled and was not held in 2020 and 2021.

The objective of the Tourism Fair, is to promote and disseminate products, services, and tourist potential of the country and place them on the route of preferred destinations in the region and in the world.

Tour Operators; Travel Agencies; Tourist Resorts; Tour Transporters; Airlines; Catering Establishments; Arts and Culture doers; Event Promoters; Television networks; Complementary services to tourism; National and foreign public institutions; was part of the fair. The FIKANI Fair is a platform for promoting tourism supply, cultural diversity, partnerships between market players, and dissemination of investment and business opportunities.

A space dedicated to the exhibition of the best of Mozambique, the region, and the world. It is privileged for networking and is expected, during the 3 days of the exhibition, the presence of about 183 exhibitors and the movement of more than 4.800 visitors.

The VIII Edition of the fair was attended by 26 buyers who facilitate business by making scheduled appointments between exhibitors and buyers. This allowed exhibitors and buyers to interact and maximize sales and purchasing potential.

In this Edition, the fair was held at the Joaquim Chissano International Conference Center, in Maputo City, the capital of the country, occupying an exhibition area of about 2,500m2, with a capacity for the placement of 150 Stands.

The 8th edition of FIKANI served as a space for strategic partnership establishments with a view to promoting the destination of Mozambique, being highlighted:

- **Mozambique Telecom**, Sa, which aims at interinstitutional cooperation for the development of activities that contribute to making Mozambique a preferred tourist destination, using technology promotion platforms on an exclusive basis;
- **Xonguila Magazine**, with a view to the growthof tourism in Mozambique, through the use of information platforms, which includes Xonguila Magazine and social networks associated with it;
- **Mult Choice Mocambique**, with a view to supporting the dissemination of advertising campaigns about the destination Mozambique in the channels available on the platforms of MultiChoice, DStv platform.

#### **Opening ceremony**

The official opening of the 8th Edition of FIKANI 2022 – International Tourism Fair was directed by His Excellency, Filipe Jacinto Nyusi, President of the Republic of Mozambique, and guests, thus highlighting the presence of Members of the Government, Diplomatic Corps, leaders of the public and private institutions and a recorded message from His Excellency Secretary General of the World Tourism Organization (UNWTO).

The opening ceremony consisted of 4 main moments, the first being the arrival of the guests, which was brightened by the performance of the cultural group followed by the cutting of the ribbon and presentation of the main stand of the Ministry of Culture and Tourism.

The second moment was characterized by the visit to the stands of several exhibitors, where His Excellency Filipe Jacinto Nyusi, President of the Republic of Mozambique interacted with the respective representatives of the companies and exhibiting institutions.





#### **Exposure**

For the exhibition participated national and foreign exhibitors in the categories of gastronomy, arts and crafts, and services distributed in stands inside and outside the building that exhibited to visitors their products and services tourist, cultural, and other complementary of the sector.





#### **Tourism Investment and Development Seminar**

The margin of the 8th Edition of FIKANI, took place a Seminary of Investment and development of Tourism, which aimed to analyze the integrated development of tourism in SADC, sharing synergies that can contribute to the creation of the Destination SADC. The attraction of more investments in the sector so that tourism increases its contribution to the economic development of Mozambique.

During the seminar, two-panel discussions were set up.

- Challenges of Tourism Development in the SADC Region;
- Investment Opportunity in the tourism sector in Mozambique.

#### **First International Conference of Catering**

The 1st International Conference on Restaurant and Catering, whose slogan was "Challenges of Catering Restoration and Events in the Context of COVID-19".

The event was chaired by His Excellency Eldevina Materula, Minister of Culture and Tourism, with the intervention of His Excellency Vicente Joaquim, Secretary of the State of Maputo City, and was attended by about 270 guests including businessmen in the sector, national and international speakers and students of hospitality and tourism. The main purpose of this conference was to discuss, list, debate, and seek solutions to the problems of the sector.

#### **Buyer/Buyers Participation in FIKANI**

FIKANI – 2022, had 26 foreign buyers/buyers being mostly from South Africa, and a German media journalist from DW International.

Event (MICE) and leisure services have aroused greater interest from buyers/buyers. During the visit to Maputo City and Province, buyers interacted with the provinces, visited the stands, and also participated in the Speed Marketing session with representatives of the provincial sector.

In order to familiarize buyers with the services and tourist products offered, familiarization visits were made to the tourist destination Maputo City and Maputo province. This action had the collaboration and partnership of several actors of the tourism chain among them hoteliers, national and South African companies, travel agencies, restaurants, and MICULTUR through INATUR.

Around half of its land lies at 3000 meters above sea level or more. But don't worry if you cannot travel for a couple of weeks at high altitude. You can still enjoy nature at its beautiful best in places like the Fann Mountains. In fact, the altitude in Tajikistan varies from 300 to 7495 meters above sea level and offers various opportunities to tour the country.



## **JISEV VALLEY HIKING**

Why not take a day trip and spend the night in the Jisev valley to get away from the Pamir Highway? You will lose any phone or internet connection as well as motorized traffic when you cross the river. To reach the first village, you must walk for about two hours, climbing and descending a steep path that hugs the side of the hills. You'll pass roaring rivers and inaccessible highland lakes along the route. You might even discover wild cherries growing near to the rivers if you visit in August. Jisev's villages are made up of just a few dwellings. Sleep in real Pamiri homes while traveling and take in the scenery.



## ISKANDERKUL LAKE – LAKE OF ALEXANDER

Hear the local lore of Alexander the Great and his horse on Iskanderkul's coast. Alexander the Great is known as Iskander in his own land, while Kul means lake. Isn't it incredible that a myth about Alexander conquering Asia has survived in this distant nation? Can you picture how the legend was passed down orally for a number of millennia from parents to children? It's your time to research the legend of the legendary warrior and conjure him standing by a lake.



## WAKHAN VALLEY



The Wakhan is now a tranquil valley, but it was once a flashpoint between colonial masters Britain and Tsarist Russia. Visit the Yamchun fortification remains, which were constructed in the 12th century, and bathe in the Bibi Khanum hot springs. Locals consider the water to be exceptional and believe it will increase female fertility. After several days of traveling, visiting the hot spring facility built up against the stalactite walls of the cliff cave is an unusual and enjoyable experience. The Wakhan has some of the most breathtaking scenery in the nation, no matter where you go.

## YAGNOB VALLEY



Due to the severe winter weather, Yagnob Valley is a special region that is inaccessible for about half of the year. The Yagnobi people have been able to keep their ancient Sogdian language alive for conversation because to this natural division, but the ancient writing system has been lost. After the Arab conquest, they relocated to the valley where they cut off contact with other cultures for several centuries, preserving a distinct culture and language as if they had been sealed in a time capsule.

# FUJAIRAH

The majority of the UAE's (United Arab Emirates) eastern coast and the Hajar Mountain region are both included in the Emirate of Fujairah. Fujairah City, a contemporary industrial town with few tourist attractions, serves as its primary hub.

Despite the fact that Fujairah city is a grid of high-rise business buildings, you may not want to spend much time there, the emirate has a lot to offer.

The beaches of Fujairah Emirate in the north draw a regular stream of tourists seeking a less hectic sun and sand getaway than Dubai has to offer. One of the best areas to go scuba diving in the UAE is along this stretch of beach.

The Emirate of Fujairah's section of the Hajar Mountains offers hiking opportunities within the rugged desert mountain heartland as well as opportunities for scenic road trips, despite the fact that the sand is the main point of interest for tourists.

## **Beach Time & Diving in Al Aqah**



Most visitors seeking sun and sand in the Emirate of Fujairah make their way to Al Aqah, where a lengthy beach encircles the coastline and Snoopy Island dominates the view of the Gulf of Oman from the sun loungers.

Al Aqah, which is 45 kilometers north of Fujairah City, is one of the UAE's less developed resort areas. There are only a few five-star hotels scattered along the beachfront, but much more development is anticipated in the near future.

For the time being, this is still the place to go if you want a peaceful beach vacation away from Dubai's packed beaches.

The beach resort hotels that line the area's coastline offer facilities for divers, snorkelers, and paddleboarders in addition to guests looking for leisurely days spent sunbathing.

Al Aqah is the epicenter of the UAE's scuba diving culture, and while the reefs in the Gulf of Oman offshore are not as famous as the Red Sea in the Middle East, there is still a ton of fish life to witness.

The primary dive locations are the vehicle cemetery site and two intentionally sunk wrecks that serve as divers' artificial reef (created during the 1980s when a series of cars and trucks were sunk to create an artificial reef for local fishermen).

For divers, there is an abundance of marine life, including big shoals of fish like trevally and parrotfish, as well as turtles and black tip sharks that can frequently be spotted at particular locations.

## Hajar Mountains



The UAE's northern interior is traversed by the Hajar Mountains. The landscape of sharp mountain peaks is unrecognizable from what most people connect with the nation and is a popular destination for road trips.

Even on a brief drive from the west coast to the east, you can see a glimpse of the magnificent mountain views. Officially, different sections of the Hajar belong to the Fujairah, Ras Al-Khaimah, and Sharjah emirates.

The important connecting roads that travel inland, such the E18 and E87 that connect Ras Al-Khaimah to the east coast and the especially stunning E89 that runs from Masafi to Dibba Al-Fujairah in the north, provide a feast of views.

# **AL AIN**

A spectacular backdrop of the jagged Jebel Hafeet mountain overlooks the oasis city of Al Ain. The best thing to do while visiting is to make the drive to Jebel Hafeet's summit to enjoy the expansive vistas.

It's a charming, well-kept town that's simple to navigate, and it's a well-liked weekend getaway location because of its family-friendly tourist attractions like the shaded oasis with palm trees, its water park, and its esteemed zoo.

Al Ain has a long history dating back to at least 3000 BC. It is the only location in the nation to have been listed on UNESCO's World Heritage List, making it one of the top sites to visit in the UAE for tourists interested in local history and culture.



## JEBEL HAFEET



Jebel Hafeet, often known as Hafeet Mountain, rises abruptly from the outskirts of Al Ain. A visit to the summit should be at the top of your sightseeing list if you want to take panoramic pictures of the city and the surrounding desert.

The distance to the summit from the heart of Al Ain is about 56 kilometers. This peak, which rises to a height of 1,240 meters, is the highest in both the Emirate of Abu Dhabi and the United Arab Emirates (Jebel Jais near Ras Al-Khaimah is the highest).

There are several beautiful overlooks along the winding mountain road that leads to this location, and once there, the entire area is visible below you.

If you're staying in Dubai, the Al Ain Full-Day Tour gives you the opportunity to experience these and other Al Ain landmarks in a single day. The tour includes stops at the city's top historical sites, Al-Jahili Fort and Hili Archaeological Park, as well as cultural sites like the camel market. It also includes a drive up to the top of Jebel Hafeet for its beautiful views. Additionally, there are photo possibilities at the Mubazzarah Park hot springs and the Al Ain oasis. # AL AIN ZOO



Al Ain Zoo is the largest zoo in the United Arab Emirates and was founded in 1969.

African gazelles, giraffes, and elands are among the endemic creatures that can be seen, as well as Arabian antelope and Arabian oryx. There are lions, tigers, pumas, black and spotted leopards, and jaguars in the big cat enclosures. A monkey enclosure, an aviary portion, and a reptile house are also present.

More than 30% of the species that may be found here are currently listed as endangered, making the zoo noteworthy for its research facilities and breeding program for endangered native animals.

Family-friendly amenities abound, including a petting zoo, giraffe feeding experiences, camel rides, and a kids' garden that promotes biodiversity education. The Sheikh Zayed Desert Learning Center, which houses displays on the ecology and desert environment of the Arabian Gulf, is also located inside the zoo.

# RAS-AL-KHAIMAH



#### Ras Al-Khaimah is a popular getaway destination for residents of Dubai.

Al Khams village, the nearby Dhayah Fort, and the incredibly atmospheric Jazirat al-Hamra area offer additional glimpses into Emirati life prior to the mid-20th century oil boom for those interested in historical sightseeing outside of the city.

## JEBEL JAIS



Jebel Jais, which is a component of the Hajar Peak Range and is the tallest mountain in the UAE with a top elevation of 1,934 meters, is located about 55 kilometers to the northeast of Ras Al-Khaimah.

The mountain's flank is reached by a 20-kilometer road that ascends in a switchback. Along the way, there are viewing platforms where you can get a good view of the surrounding desert cliffs.

Viewing Deck Park, a collection of landscaped terraces (with cafés and other services) where visitors can gaze out over the craggy peaks all the way down to the coastal plain, is located at the top of the road.

It's one of the best locations to visit for photographers, especially in the early evening when the sun is sinking and the orange-hued rocks shine.

# KHATT SPRINGS



Khatt Springs is a region of mineral-rich hot springs where the water is renowned for its calming and therapeutic qualities. It is located about 26 kilometers southeast of Ras Al-Khaimah.

Khatt is surrounded by an oasis and flanked by arid mountains. Water from the hot springs is piped into pools that are divided based on gender.

The facilities are a little worn out now, but they're still worth a trip if you only need a quick hot water soak to ease your sore joints after traveling.

.The restored towers of Khatt Fort are located in the village, and the area's surrounding countryside is of great interest to archaeologists due to the discovery of Chalcolithicera tomb sites and 19th-century mud-brick fortifications, both of which indicate the region's long and continuous human habitation.


