
Feel The Thrill Of Canada's Natural Wonder – Niagara Falls

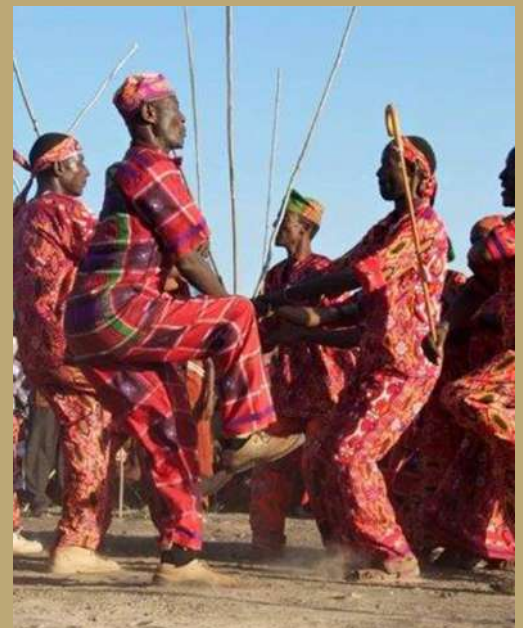

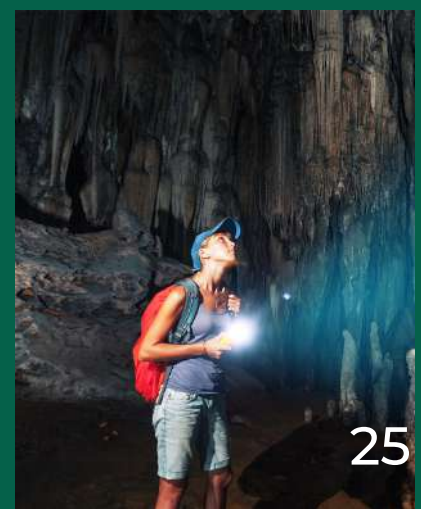

Souqs

Go to one of Oman's exciting souqs and learn about local shopping customs! You can see authentic traditional Oman in the souqs, where merchants sit on the floor and pile their goods high.

Authentic Bedouin jewellery, silver khanjars, incense burners, and frankincense can all be found at bargain prices

in the city's many souqs or marketplaces. While shopping in Oman's souks, you'll be surrounded by the sweet aroma of halwa and the heady scent of Arabian incense. Haggling is expected and encouraged at the Souq. Shop around the Souq to find the best deal, then negotiate with your preferred merchant. Explore the twisting alleys of the Omani souqs and spoil yourself with household goods, traditional apparel, fabrics, and more.

Women visiting Oman should cover their shoulders and knees at the souqs as a sign of respect for local customs. The finest Oman souks are detailed below.

Nizwa Souq

The Nizwa Souq, located within the walls of the **Nizwa Fort**, is one of Oman's oldest and most well-known marketplaces. The Nizwa Souq is packed with shops of every description, from tailors to jewellers, hardware stores, data vendors, and potters. The Souq has a market for live livestock every Friday, including cattle and goats. The Souq's architecture is fascinating since it blends old and modern styles. The Souq's gorgeous sandy-coloured structures give it a distinct and alluring appearance. Beautiful ceramics, sterling silver jewellery, and many dates can be found anywhere. Exotic fruits and vegetables and fresh meat and seafood occupy a sizable section of the Souqs.



Haffa/Al Husn Market

The Al Husn Souq is the most popular market in **Salalah** because it is the city's oldest and largest Souq. The Souq is well-known for its enormous stock of aromatic frankincense, but it also offers stunning silver jewellery and other handicrafts.

Famous silver daggers (known locally as Khanjars), ceramic coffee pots (known locally as Dallahs), tasselled turbans, and wonderful frankincense can all be found at Salalah's biggest market.

The local shops offer a variety of frankincense products, including coals, burners, oils, lotions, and perfumes. Even ice cream and honey made with frankincense can be sampled.

The remarkable Gold Souq may be found in one area; here, you can have custom jewellery made by goldsmiths. Gold Salalah beads are the most sought-after trinkets in the gold Souq. The Al Husn Souq comes alive with activity and romance when you visit it after dark.



Muttrah Souq

The Muttrah Souq in Muscat is the most popular tourist shopping destination in all of Oman, and it is built in the style of a typical Arab market (except for its timber roofing). Small, colourful stores and booths selling anything from Bedu jewelry to frankincense and myrrh line the narrow streets of the Souq.

The entire Souq is a labyrinth, with narrow alleys selling gold and winding avenues selling wooden souvenirs. Frankincense and other Arabian smells fill the air as you enter the Souq. The Souq comes to life at night, when travelers may barter with shopkeepers, and lamps illuminate the wooden walls of the buildings.

Locals refer to the Souq as ***“The Market of Darkness”*** because of its maze of narrow lanes and alleys preventing light from entering. Gold and silver jewellery can be found in the narrow streets of Muttrah’s Gold Souq.

The popular Omani dessert Halwa and a few different spices can be found at the various kiosks. Visiting the Muttrah Souq is equally parts confusing and exciting.



Ladies Souq Ibra

On Wednesdays, the desert village of Ibra becomes one of the liveliest and most colourful Middle Eastern souqs. On Wednesdays, the market is exclusive to women. The market is closed to men on Wednesdays so that women vendors can sell only to other women. Women from all across the Bedouin region bring their wares to sell in the Souq, which includes anything from jewelry and textiles to cosmetics and home goods.

The women, who wear stunning abayas and hijabs, are kind, friendly, and hospitable. Women sell goat's milk, honey, and cheese in another section of the Souq—a welcome change from the male-dominated atmosphere of other Omani markets.



Downtown Area Central Muscat
