# Insights on Trade, Educational and Tourism Relationships between Malaysia and UAE

Malaysia is one of the Asian Tigers, a set of economically emerging countries that are seeing a large increase in their economic growth in the past couple of decades. Whereas, UAE is another emerging Middle Eastern economy, which relies on its oil exports, growth in real estate, and new

enterprise startups.

Recently, the Chairman of Iqra Group, Dr. S.M. Tahir had an opportunity to meet with the Consul General of

Malaysia, H.E. Mr. Mohammed Fadly Amri Aliaman. The focus of their conversation was mainly on the relations between the two nations and covered a wide array of topics including, education, trading activities, and tourism.

### **Trade**

H.E. Mr. Mohammed Fadly discussed the current account trade balance between both countries, saying that the partnership between both countries has strengthened in recent years indicated by the



increase in trade by almost 7%. Excellency admitted that currently, it was the UAE that had a positive balance on the current account largely due to the great proportion of oil imported by Malaysia (accounting for 40% of Malaysian imports from the UAE). Furthermore, he discussed that Malaysia's main exports to UAE were palm oil and tin.



When asked about the areas of greater potential in trade between both countries, Excellency stated that Artificial



Intelligence seems to be the prime candidate especially considering that UAE stresses the latest technology and sustainable projects. Excellency believed that the collaboration between both countries on this technology would help them to expand trade and generate new employment opportunities.

There was also a discussion over what steps Malaysian authorities were taking to encourage entrepreneurs to export more to the UAE. To which Excellency replied that the Malaysian Trade Development Corporation had overseen this matter, providing guidance and monetary assistance (subsidies) to new startups to increase their exports. Furthermore, Excellency also stressed the importance of exhibitions and events to make "ones presence felt in the UAE", this is because the UAE is a large and competitive market.

### **Education**

When speaking on academic collaborations between both states, Excellency stated that it has been good but requires further expansion. Excellency says that 1020 UAE



students are studying in Malaysia whereas; only 50 Malaysians are doing so in the UAE. Excellency believes that this difference is an indication that more efforts are required to maintain the balance in this matter. There have also been multiple exchange programs between many universities in both countries. Moreover, measures to expand Malaysian institutes in UAE include, visiting high schools in UAE and informing them about the cultural and academic facilities present in the country of Malaysia.

The topic of exchange programs was also talked about and the Excellency said that assistance was being provided to Malaysian students regarding admissions in the UAE and other Middle Eastern countries in the form of guidance. Furthermore, open houses are being held for UAE students to inform them about the higher educational facilities and institutes in Malaysia.

### **Online Learning**

When discussing e-learning Excellency felt that since the children are becoming more and more accustomed to the use of technology, hence online learning is possible on a level like never before.



Excellency said that the pandemic lead to the growth of many online learning tools which have drastically increased the standard of education gained online.

### **Tourism**

H.E. Mr. Mohammed Fadly said that Malaysia has the potential to attract more tourists from the UAE. Excellency

believes that natural destinations, areas of natural greenery, and divergent landscapes ranging from the mountains in Penang to beaches in Lankavi would be a new experience for UAE tourists from the bustling metropolitan.



He further stated that steps were being taken to make the Malaysian locals aware of the various attractions and tourist destinations in the UAE.

It was felt that the discussion provides valuable insights into the existing relationships between Malaysia and the UAE and different areas where their collaboration needs more improvement. In addition to this, since Malaysia and the UAE both are emerging economies, thus they can benefit immensely from their association and partnership together.





### Iguazu Falls: Where Nature Reigns Supreme and Adventures Await

Iguazu Falls, one of the most stunning waterfalls on Earth, can be found in Brazil, a nation famed for its breathtaking natural beauties. This **UNESCO World Heritage site**, tucked away in the thick jungles of the Iguazu National Park,

draws tourists from all over the world who come to see the falls' incredible beauty and majesty. In this article, we shall explore the terrain, abundant biodiversity, cultural significance, and unmatched experiences that Iguazu Falls offers.



The Iguazu Falls are located on the border of Argentina and Brazil, with most of the falls being on the Argentinean side. The Iguazu River, which rises in Brazil's Paraná state and meanders through a variety of deep rainforests before crashing over a number of cliffs, is responsible for creating the falls. The **Devil's Throat (Garganta del Diablo),** a U-shaped cascade with a magnificent height of 269 feet (82 metres), is unquestionably the Iguazu Falls' crowning glory. On the Argentinean side, the Devil's Throat offers an amazing spectacle as the water roars down into an abyss of mist, creating an unearthly



atmosphere. Visitors can experience the power of nature up close by watching this show from a number of observation platforms.

Visitors can explore a network of paths and walkways on the Brazilian side for panoramic views of the falls from

different perspectives. The boardwalk leading to the base of the **Floriano Falls**, where tourists may experience the incredible force and thunderous sound of the cascades, is unquestionably the highlight. The **Macuco Safari**, a boat ride that takes visitors on a thrilling excursion



into the centre of the falls and offers an adrenaline-pumping adventure and a soothing shower in the mist, is another well-liked activity.

Beyond its magnificent waterfalls, the Iguazu National Park is a haven for biodiversity. Biodiversity is important for conservation. The park includes a sizable portion of natural rainforest, which supports an extraordinary variety of flora and fauna. The complex ecology supports over 2,000 plant species, including enormous trees, vivid orchids, and unusual ferns. In addition, the park is home to over 400 species of birds, including toucans and the recognisable great dusky swifts, as well as many other animals like jaguars, tapirs, and capybaras.

Brazil and Argentina have implemented major conservation measures to safeguard this vulnerable habitat. The first binational park in South America, Iguazu National Park, was created in 1934. In 1984, UNESCO listed it as a World Heritage property. The park management strongly emphasises









environmentally friendly tourist strategies to enable people to enjoy the falls with the least possible environmental damage.
